Owens Valley clients: hard time managed Medi-Cal – providers – no heart doctor options

Psychiatry services impossible with managed MediCal

Case management request can help.

Managed care—single case agreement

Pause on FMS services

Timeliness of payments

Service Coordinator challenges

More staff – hiring new service coordinators

Orientation

Follow up – newly revised IPP approval form

Providing families with SDP information – cannot just hand out the flyer. Need to be able to explain the program. Flyer asks families to call for more information.
