

Notice of Intent

KRC 2223-6

Kern Regional Center (KRC) issues Request for Proposals (RFP) when there is a need to develop specific homes, programs, or specialized services for clients. Current RFPs can be viewed here (<u>https://kernrc.org/service-providers/service-provider-resources/rfpcrdp-cpp/</u>).

The Department of Developmental Services (DDS) awarded KRC \$150,000 in start-up funds as part of the Community Placement Plan (CPP) and Community Resource Development Plan (CRDP) for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 to develop an Adult Crisis Residential Facility in Bakersfield. KRC released an RFP (Project number- KRC 2223-6) on April 11, 2023 to develop an Adult Crisis Residential Facility (090 Service Code) for adults 18 to 59 years old to serve KRC individuals in Kern, Inyo, and Mono counties.

This notice is to inform the public, KRC intends to contract with Donnell Court II to serve up to three (3) adults with developmental disabilities who need crisis intervention and stabilization, and require 24-hour care and supervision, and whose needs cannot be appropriately met within the array of other community living options available. Donnell Court II was awarded the RFP and was provided a Selection Notification Letter on June 9, 2023.
