Project SEARCH

Project SEARCH is an international, unique, business-led, one year paid internship program that takes place entirely at the workplace.

Collaborating with PathPoint, workplace immersion facilitates a seamless combination of classroom instruction, career exploration, and hands-on training. Currently we have Project SEARCH collaboration with the Kern County Library.

The sole definition of a successful outcome is competitive employment for each Project SEARCH intern. Interns learn relevant, marketable skills while immersed in the business world. Businesses are active partners, participating without subsidies. The program focus is on serving young adults with a variety of developmental disabilities, who experience total immersion in the workplace. Project SEARCH graduates receive effective follow-along services to retain employment.
