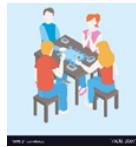

## CAC Meeting

Date: August 12, 2025

Attendees: 9 individuals in person (including staff) and 5 online participants.

Welcome and introductions: The chair greeted everyone.

Icebreaker question: What is your favorite season?

Some participants shared that they enjoy winter and fall, appreciating the cooler weather and seasonal atmosphere. Others mentioned enjoying summer for activities like hiking, visiting lakes, and spending time at the beach. Football season was the favorite, described as fun, exciting, and unifying bringing people together regardless of the weather.

Chair report:

With the Legislature on summer break, the Chair will share CAC and housing-related updates and federal/state information at the next board meeting.

Presentation:

Emergency preparedness for the KRC Community, the emphasis on the need for personalized emergency plans, especially for those with medical or accessibility needs. They discussed using non-electric communication tools, registering for alerts like the ASN list, and building support networks.

Individuals ask if it is true that people from emergency programs will come to the house and let you know that there will be a power outage for those who have medical needs?

A participant shared that during extreme temperatures, he drinks plenty of water, starts his day early, and prepares meals that help with hydration, such as salads.

There was a conversation about the Blue Envelope Program, people seem unsure if the program is available locally.

An individual asks if there is an APP for the phone that can provide alerts.

A participant shared that she has suffered from epilepsy since the age of two and finds it challenging to carry her medication.

Additional resources mentioned by other attendees, Autism Society, the ARC, NAD, Easter Seals, Listos California (for Spanish speakers).
